Historic Montana Documents Available Online via ImagineIF

Kalispell, MT – ImagineIF Libraries now offer access to a collection of digitized historic and current Montana state government information through the library catalog.

The materials date back to the late 1800s, and the PDF files may be viewed online, downloaded, saved or printed. They include state agency annual reports, employee statistics, historic Montana promotional material, environmental impact statements, newsletters, natural resource maps and more.

“These materials may be invaluable to historians and researchers,” ImagineIF Director Kim Crowley said. “It’s an incredibly rich collection and we appreciate the Montana State Library’s willingness to make it accessible to the public.”

To access these documents, visit an ImagineIF location or www.imagineiflibraries.org. Click on “Search the Catalog,” then enter search terms and check the box for “Digital/Electronic Content” to narrow the results. Look for online resources located in the State Government Information Center.

The number of items available via the library catalog will continue to grow as more digital documents are added to the Montana State Library’s collection.
