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New Offerings for Children at ImagineIF Columbia Falls

Kalispell, MT – In addition to a newly remodeled space at ImagineIF Columbia Falls, library staff are offering an updated variety of interactive experiences and programs for children. These changes are based on the community's unique needs and seek to provide library customers with programs that appeal to them and their families.

A brand-new program, Toddler Time, is now offered on Monday mornings at 11 a.m. The Books and Babies program in Columbia Falls has been discontinued. Preschool Storytime on Wednesday mornings will continue.

After-School Storytime, formerly offered on Wednesday afternoons, is no longer taking place at ImagineIF Columbia Falls. Instead, children in grades K-6 will be invited to participate in hands-on experiences, play and exploration, such as the Moon Madness activities that took place all week before the recent lunar eclipse and supermoon. These themed activities, with new selections each month, offer children more opportunities for personal exploration and fit with a variety of learning styles.

Programs and activities at ImagineIF Libraries are free, and registration is not required. Attendees are welcome to bring siblings of other ages; there are always toys to be found and new friends to be made.
